

2024-2025 Student Attendance Guidelines

The Wapaskwa Virtual Collegiate (WVC) promotes an environment conducive to all students' success. Successful students are present, prepared for instruction, and actively participate in the online learning environment. The WVC requires that students attend classes regularly.

Absences, for whatever reason, remove students from the learning activities and reduce the chances of an overall successful experience. The WVC teachers will work with students, parents (for those under 18), and the school facilitator to promote consistent attendance and communicate about absences, whether excused or unexcused and any persistent attendance issues.

The student attendance interventions for the 2024-2025 school year include:

Voluntary Withdrawal (VW)

Students (with parental approval under 18) and/or facilitators may decide to VW from any class they have been falling behind, allowing them to focus on the remaining classes in their timetable. A formal letter is compiled, sent to the student's home via Canada Post, and copied to the facilitators and the WVC instructors.

Involuntary Withdrawal (IW)

Students who fail to respond to the teacher's notifications and concerns regarding their absenteeism will be administratively removed or involuntarily withdrawn from gaining credits through the online program. A notification letter will be sent to the student's home via Canada Post and the WVC instructional staff; school facilitators are copied. Students will not receive a Grade at the end of the semester.

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
